

## Location & How to get to Terraces

### By plane and hire car or taxi

Newcastle Airport is at Williamtown, 30 minutes north of the city. Follow the city signs turning left after you cross the river from Kooragang Is. and left again into Honeysuckle Drive keeping



Newcastle Harbour on your left. Proceed along Wharf Rd, turn right at the Watt St roundabout, left into Scott St, left again into Telford St.

### By car

From Sydney, follow the F3 exiting on the Newcastle/Wallsend Link Rd. In the city, this road becomes Parry and then King St. From Maitland and the New England Hwy, and on the Pacific Hwy from the north (joining Maitland Rd at Hexham), drive straight down Hunter St to the Mall and proceed along Scott St, left into Telford St.



### By train or coach

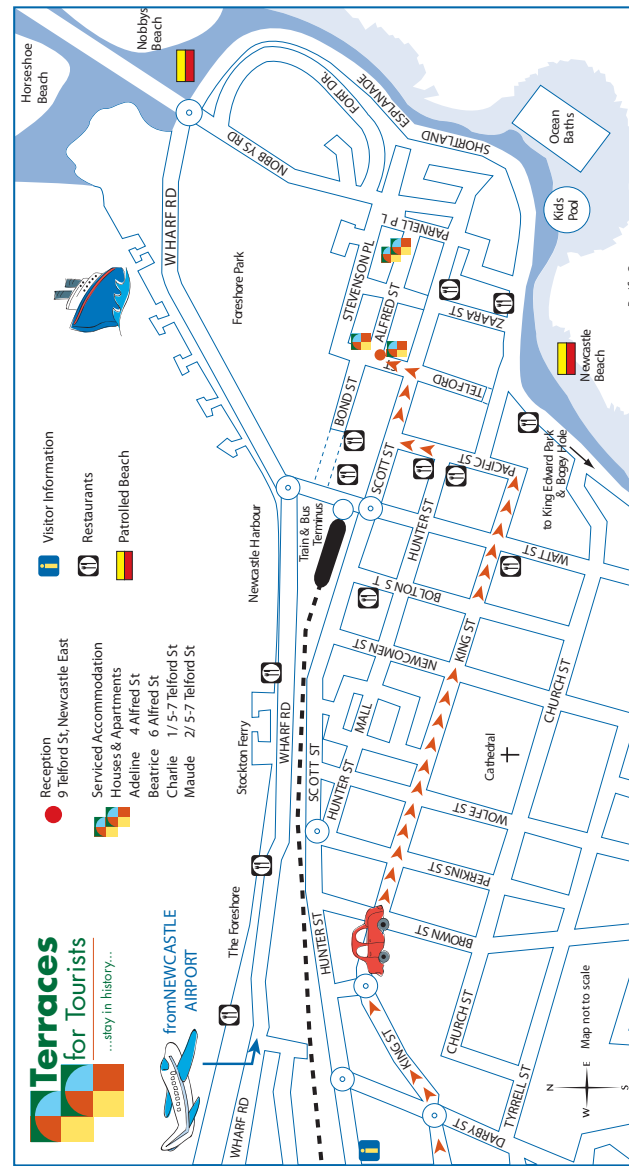
Both terminate at Newcastle Railway Station. Walk one block east along Bond St, turn right into Telford St or go along Scott St, turn left into Telford St.



Stay in **Terraces** by the beach on Australia's Hunter Coast.

A stroll from Newcastle shops and restaurants, beaches, ocean baths, parklands, the harbour and numerous historic city sites.



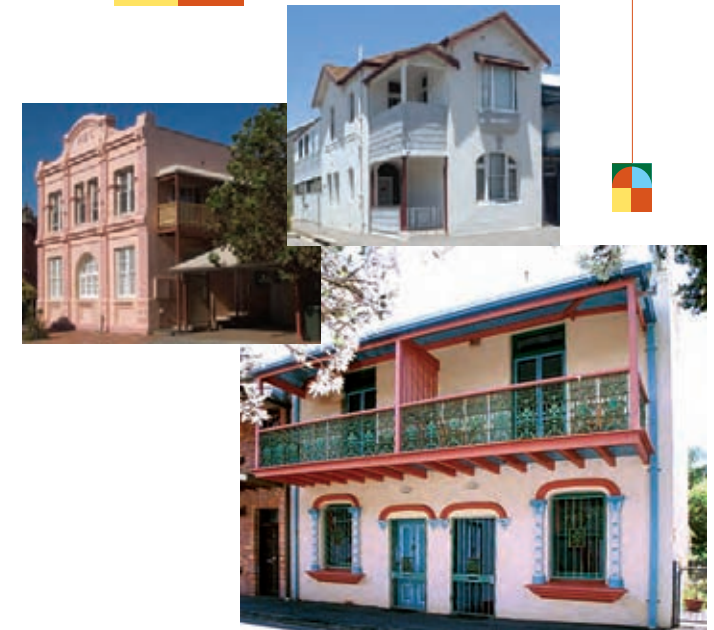

## Adeline & Beatrice



**Adeline & Beatrice** are lovingly restored two-storey terrace houses. Built in 1885 by Mary's great grandparents, renovated and modernised in the 1990s, these rococo facade terrace houses are side by side at 4 & 6 Alfred St near Parnell Place.

Each two bedroom house has its own unique style, both have the same amenities:

- Upstairs main bedroom with king bed and ceiling fan
- French doors to front balcony and café setting
- Second bedroom with two single beds
- Spacious bathroom with full size bath
- Downstairs living room, separate dining room, gas space heating
- Laundry and second toilet with hand basin
- Galley kitchen with all mod cons including dishwasher
- Interconnected courtyard garden on sunny north side
- Gas barbecue, outdoor table setting and beach shower
- Rear lane pedestrian access

## Charlie & Maude



**Charlie & Maude** are newly renovated 2 bedroom ground floor apartments at 1/5-7 and 2/5-7 Telford St, just across Alfred St from Terraces Reception.

The building, dating from 1884, was originally a warehouse for goods unloaded from the wharves nearby. It was transformed into Newcastle Business College (NBC) in the 1920s where young men and women learned accounting upstairs and typing downstairs. In the 1980s it began a new life as a block of 5 apartments.

Both **Charlie & Maude** have adjacent undercover car parks and a shared courtyard with barbecue. They are configured and equipped for guests with disabilities.

### Charlie features

- Main bedroom with king bed and harbour views, second with single bed, both with large built-in robes and plantation shutters
- Generous wheelchair-friendly bathroom, level floor open shower, grab rails, heated towel rail
- Spacious, stylish living-dining room, polished timber floors, plantation shutters, ceiling fan, air conditioning, view down Bond St to Customs House and north to Newcastle Harbour

### Maude features

- Open plan kitchen with dishwasher, laundry facilities including dryer
- Main bedroom with queen bed, second with single bed, both with large built-ropes and plantation shutters
- Generous bathroom, shower over small bath, grab rails, heated towel rail
- Spacious carpeted living-dining room with ceiling fan, large sliding glass door opening to courtyard garden
- Open plan kitchen with dishwasher, laundry facilities

## Accommodation & Amenities



- Self-contained serviced city accommodation near the beach
- Suitable for holiday and corporate lets
- Fully furnished and equipped with linen, cutlery, crockery
- Fold up extra bed available, also baby cot and high chair
- Free on-street parking, some off-street available
